Joe Biden. De Scranton à la Maison Blanche

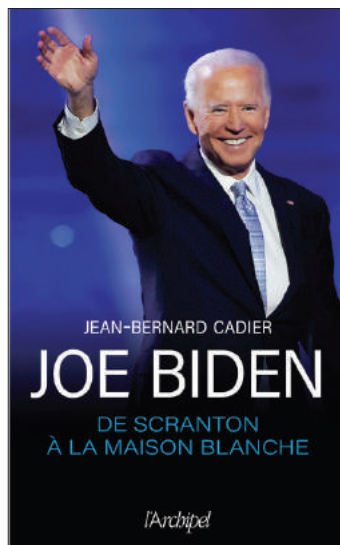
*A complete biography about

On November 7th, 2020, after 4 suspenseful days, Joe Biden finally was elected United States' 46th President. Pennsylvania, his native state, made him the winner. His victory is dedicated to his son Beau, who died of a cancer in 2015.

Jean-Bernard Cadier recounts Joe Biden's life, from his childhood in Scranton, Pennsylvania, to the White House – including his years as Barack Obama's vice-President. His personal dramas (his wife and daughter's death in a car crash, his son's death), disgraces (his vote in 2002 supporting Iraq War, his options on race issues) and scandals (his son Hunter's business in Ukraine).

He studies how the new President will cope with a deeply divided country.

He lives and works in Saint Martha's House and not in the papal apartments; he drives a modest car; he states he only is Rome's first Bishop.

But, through all these little revolutions, could the Pope really change the Church, as he wanted to? Based on an investigation led in Roma, this biography enlightens his seven pontifical years and the pope's difficulties with his own troops.

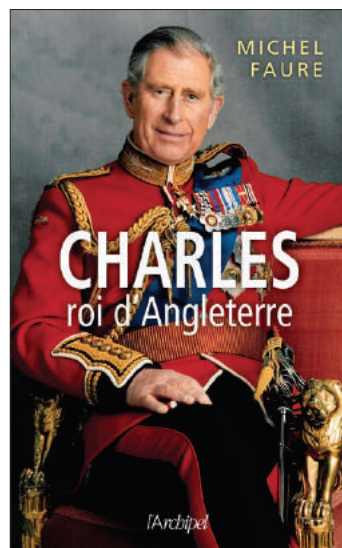
Who is he really?

Now 72, the Prince of Wales still is in the waiting room. He presides over 400 charity organizations, with a gentle smile and a kind word for everyone; he is publicly serious and intimately mischievous.

Since his young age, Charles enjoyed many delights. Perhaps out of boredom, but also because he is a hedonist – and can afford to be. Polo, girls, studies, weapons learning, and a taste for uniforms and well-cut suits... The Prince has always been a dandy.

But there also are his affairs – including Camilla Shand (ex-Parker Bowles). In 1981, his wedding with Diana was at the front page of all newspapers around the world, as was the birth of their two kids, their divorce, then the death of the rebellious princess in a car crash in Paris in 1997. After some time, Camilla reappeared – actually, she never really disappeared. She is the love of his life.

Michel Faure examines the man, prince, husband, father and now grandfather, who sometimes drives a James Bond-like Aston Martin (fueled with biodiesel), who was a green activist ahead of his time, who loves to garden, to do some magic tricks, to paint watercolors. He heals himself with homeopathy, played cello in his youth and takes a cold shower every morning. Briefly said, he is an old kid-to-be-king, who keeps his mysteries.

J'ai séquestré Kim Kardashian

A kidnapper's confession

On October 3rd, 2016, news hit international press and social networks: Kim Kardashian, the host of the famous reality TV show *Keeping Up With the Kardashians*, who stayed in a very fashionable Parisian resort for the Fashion Week, got robbed of 9 million euros worth of jewelry.

At around 2:30a.m., all five robbers, dressed up as police officers, came into her room and put a gun to her head while they robbed her before locking her in her bathroom. She was finally freed by (real) police. "They grabbed me and took me into the hallway. They tied me up with plastic cables and taped my hands, then they put tape over my mouth and my legs", she told journalists.

One of the thieves, Yunicé Abbas, recounts from the inside the setting up, the robbery, then the final fiasco of this heist.

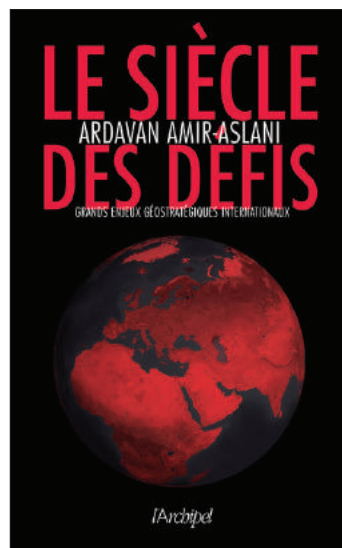
Le siècle des défis

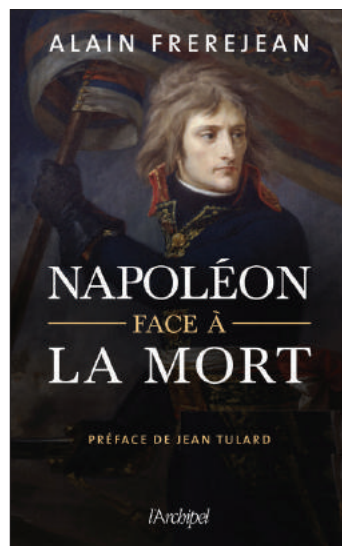

This passionate relationship will inspire him some of his most beautiful poems. Yet, Jeanne is despised: she has a black skin and her poor origins are unsettling. However, both remain deeply in love. In a passionate way: they are jealous, they get mad, they fight and cheat on each other.

In this biography, Brigitte Kernel recounts a love story as intense as stormy, based on Baudelaire's letters. A consuming passion that will burn the poet until his death in 1867, aged 46.

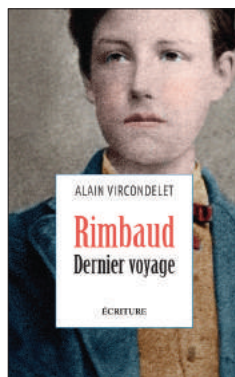
RIMBAUD. HIS LAST JOURNEY

Rimbaud, dernier voyage

On April 7th, 1891, Arthur Rimbaud, 36, is getting back to France to be taken care of. His travel from Aden, Yemen, is stormy: in a caravan, he goes through dangerous territories and arrives in Marseille weeks later, on May 20th, where he is hospitalized. His mother meets him there but goes back to Roche, their farm in the Ardennes, where Rimbaud's sister, Isabelle, is ill too.

Without his right leg, Rimbaud is driven to despair and decides to come back to Roche too. But he cannot travel and has to stay in Marseille, with his sister this time, where he dies on November 10th.

Alain Vircondelet depicts the poet's final journey, unveiling many of his secrets: why did he want to go back in Roche? What is his peculiar relationship with his sister? Did he really recover faith in Catholicism?

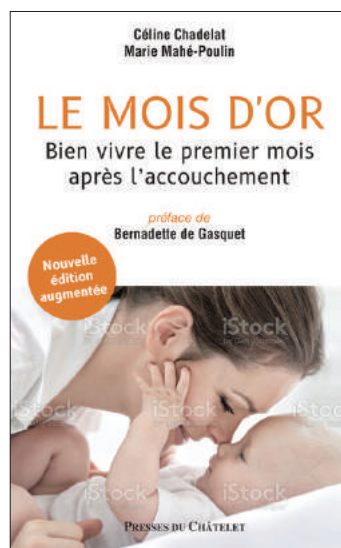
How can a mother fully cope and enjoy all 30 days following childbirth, a difficult moment in a woman's life?

This guide unveils the reality of that crucial moment in the life of a mother, a father and a couple. It points out how to take advantages of specific practices, and prevents many troubles: recovering from baby blues and post-birth difficulties, lowering risks of depression and burn out, overcoming negative emotions, avoiding physical problems, maintaining the couple stable...

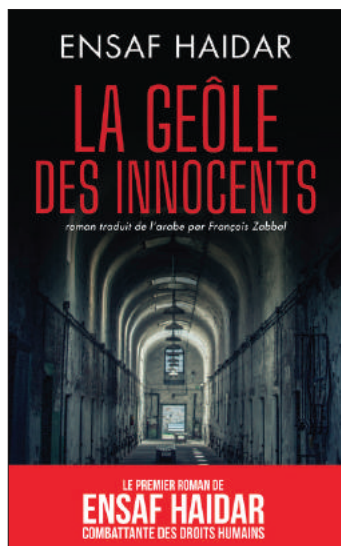

She found political asylum in Sherbrooke, Canada. She was awarded the Sakharov Price for Freedom of thought in 2015. She then founded the Raif Badawi Foundation for Freedom in Québec. She is the author of *Raif Badawi The Voice of Freedom. My Husband, Our Story* (The Other Press, 2016; l'Archipel, 2016).

Mbappé, le phénomène

The first complete biography by an insider

Time Magazine chose him in October 2018 to illustrate their international cover titled “Next Generation Leaders”. Aged 19, King Pelé’s inheritor became more than a soccer player: a world icon. The one who brandished the FIFA World Cup in Moscow on July 15th. Who could have foreseen such a rise for that young boy? Kylian MBappé was born in Bondy, Paris suburb, where he first played soccer (and also transverse flute) before joining the Clairefontaine Soccer Academy. Then Monaco where he became professional and won his first French championship. Summer 2017: an outstanding transfer. He left Monaco to Paris Saint-Germain against 180 M€. Question is now to guess if the one who breaks every record is unstoppable?

This thorough biography reveals the real Kylian Mbappé. Did his first educators imagine such a rise? What do his teammates think about him? Who is he in the real life? How does he live? How much does he earn? 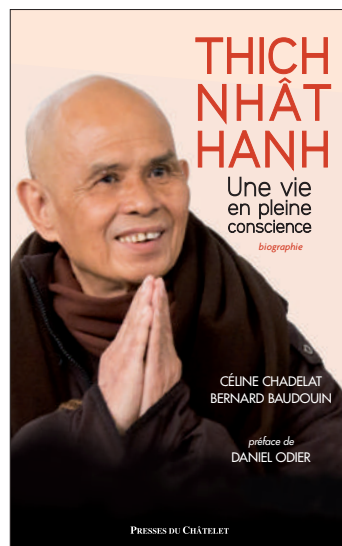

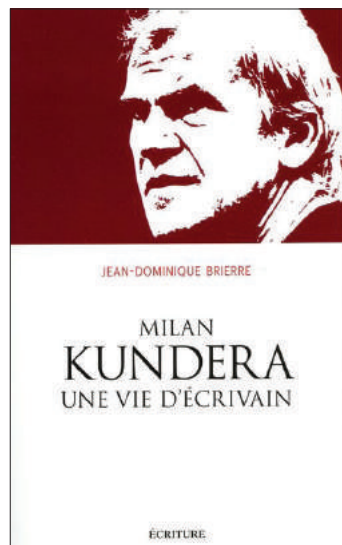

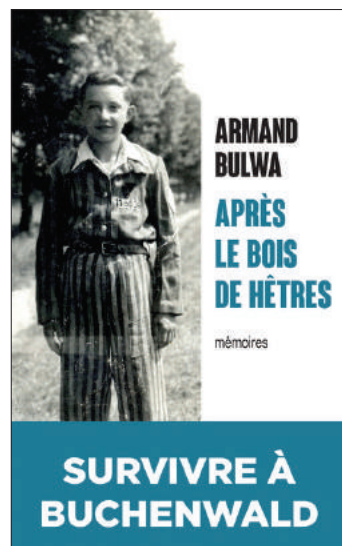

Armand Bulwa is one of the last camp survivors. Born, in 1928, Aaron Bulwa, in Piotrków (Poland) – the first ghetto set in 1939 by Nazis in this country, he was kept prisoner for five years before being released in Buchenwald on 11th April 1945 by US soldiers, shocked to discover one thousand children among the prisoners. About four hundred were taken care of by the OSE ("Oeuvre de Secours aux enfants"), including Israël Meir Lau (who became Chief Rabbi of Israel) and future Nobel Prize Elie Wiesel.

This book is his life story. He recounts his childhood in the ghetto, the Polish school on morning and *heder* on afternoon, while hatred of Jews grew in his home country. He married a French lady named Bulwa whose family greeted him when he arrived in France in 1945, and lives in Paris.
