



MICHEL PETRUCCIANI

The first thorough biography of the great pianist who passed away 25 years ago

Born in Orange (Vaucluse, France), Michel Petrucciani, the son of a guitarist, had the brittle bone disease. But despite his condition, Petrucciani was a child prodigy, a piano and jazz enthusiast, who dreamed of becoming Duke Ellington; he started piano at 4, played with the American trumpeter Clark Terry at 13, and then with the greatest jazzmen: Charles Lloyd, Lee Konitz, Charlie Haden, Gary Peacock, Eddy Louiss, Ron Carter, Wayne Shorter, Stéphane Grappelli...

From his promising beginnings to his arrival in the USA in the 80s and his worldwide fame, the author depicts the story of an amazing but ill man, who passionately lived and played till his death in NYC, on the January 6th, 1999, aged 36.

The destiny of a great jazzman, in line with Bill Evans, Oscar Peterson and Keith Jarrett, praised for his playing inventiveness and virtuosity.



The only thorough French biography on actress, singer and style-icon Jane Birkin, who died on 16 July 2023, aged 76

Years went by but Jane Birkin remained an icon. From her beginnings as an actress in Michelangelo Antonioni's *Blow Up*, then a whispering singer as Serge Gainsbourg's muse, the "ex-fan des sixties" was truly famous all over the world.

Since 1968, when she met Serge Gainsbourg, she gets famous in France. Thus they both become one of the most famous bohemian-like couple of the Paris' Saint-Germain-des-Prés.

Besides her most famous songs ("Ex-fan des sixties", "Je t'aime moi non plus", "Quoi"…), we also could see her in cult films (Jacques Deray's *La Piscine*, Jacques Rivette's *La Belle Noiseuse*, Agnès Varda's *Jane B. par Agnès V…*) as well as on stage, directed by Patrice Chéreau.

For sure, throughout the years, the British-born actress and singer who never lost her so British accent turned into a real icon – even a Hermès bag got her name!

On 16 July 2023, Birkin was found dead at her home in Paris. She was 76 years old. The premier of the documentary *Jane by Charlotte*, directed by her daughter, actress and singer Charlotte Gainsbourg, was one of her last public appearances before her demise.




Ils ont préféré en finir. Le suicide des chefs nazis

Rommel, Goebbels, Goering, Himmler, Hess... Nazi leaders who decided to follow Hitler's ending

30 April 1945, around 3.20pm. By killing himself with Eva Braun he just married, Adolf Hitler initiates a chain reaction through the chiefs of the Third Reich. Cyanide, hanging, firearms... Many of his collaborators follow this suicidal path – Goebbels first.

Yet some of Hitler's closest collaborators, Goering and Himmler, did not want to sacrifice themselves. Goering hoped he could deal with Americans and become future Germany new Foreign Minister; and Himmler figured he could manage the transition through Sweden. But Goering's death sentence in Nuremberg and Himmler's capture gave them an unexpected ending.

44-45, at least 200 Nazi chiefs killed themselves. All had many reasons: avoiding their sentence from Allies determined to condemn them; denying their defeat and the National-socialist Government ending... Many Nazis never considered their acts as criminal, and preferred choosing, with suicide or escape, their own "final solution".

FROM COSMOS TO LIFE

Du Cosmos à la vie

(Re)discovering the story of our universe

One of the foremost French astrophysicists, Jean Audouze, and biologist Marie-Christine Maurel, get together to discuss a topic still intriguing humanity: birth of our universe and of life.

First was the universe. Its birth occurred about 13.7 billion years ago. From elementary particles to galaxies clusters, their interactions are governed by four essential interactions: gravity, electromagnetism and two nuclear forces. Since then, several generations of stars (and their clusters, named galaxies) took shape during the first billion years. Most of the chemical elements, including those that created Earth and life, emerged among stars, especially the biggest ones.

Water on Earth had an essential role. Two eras marked the evolution and the development of life: the first one, with the lack of oxygen on Earth; the second one, when it appeared, about 2 billion years ago.

The authors recount the evolution of life until the appearance of Homo Sapiens, the transformation of ecosystems – and fears induced by global warming and the exhaustion of biologic diversity.


Léopoldine Courtecuisse (Shorthip) is a hairdresser in Wahlbourg, a small town in Alsace.
