On 5th August 2021, French daily paper *Le Monde* announced the reappearance of long-lost six thousand pages manuscript, a treasure kept by a former French journalist, Jean-Pierre Thibaudat. For forty years, he devoted himself in deciphering and transcribing those manuscripts. Risking legal proceedings, he had to give them back to Lucienne Destouches, Céline's widow who died in 2017 at 107.

Since then, Gallimard – Céline's last publisher – successfully published three of his post-mortem novels. Now the case publicly known, the author – also Thibaudat's advocate – narrates the whole affair thoroughly, since Céline fled Paris in Summer 1944. He unveils the details of Céline's "Jewish file", that helped him to write his lampoons; how his lawyer made him avoid jail in 1954, when he came back from Denmark; the particulars of the trial whose Céline's family threatens Gallimard and the writer's official heirs...
