The tree is decorated perfectly for the party, but whilst Old Bear sleeps, the spiders come out to play, decorating the tree with their wondrous webs! Will Old Bear and friends see the beauty in the spiders' hard work?



Pippa Goodhart is the author of over a hundred children's books. She trained as a teacher and worked for many years in bookselling before becoming a mother and a writer.



Ema Malyauka is a children's book illustrator born in Belarus, and currently living in cozy town Alkmaar, the Netherlands. She has a large collection of sketchbooks that is constantly growing. She is a self-taught illustrator who is in love with art.

*'Christmas Cobwebs is part traditional story, and partly a story personal to me. The traditional story is one found in differing forms in several countries in Eastern Europe, but the version I've based my story on comes from Ukraine. It relates to the traditional Ukrainian Christmas tree decoration of an ornamental sparkling spider's web. That spider's web is thought to bring good luck for the coming year. But this is also a story very much about Christmas. In the traditional story, a poor widow woman brings in a tree for Christmas, but she can't afford to decorate it. However, on Christmas Eve, whilst the woman sleeps, a spider, grateful for the shelter in the woman's humble home, spins a beautiful web as a gift for her. Some tales say that the sparkling web was the inspiration for the tinsel we put in our trees.'*

*The joyful power of a surprise gift from an unexpected source rings absolutely true to me. Another personal aspect of Christmas Cobwebs is the worry I had as a child that Christmas was going to lose its magic for me once I was in the role I saw my mother playing, making each bit of Christmas happen in the right way at the right time. But that's another side of the magic of Christmas. The joy of giving truly is greater than the joy of receiving. I loved, and still, now as a granny, love, trying to make Christmas magic for others, just as Old Bear does in the story.'*

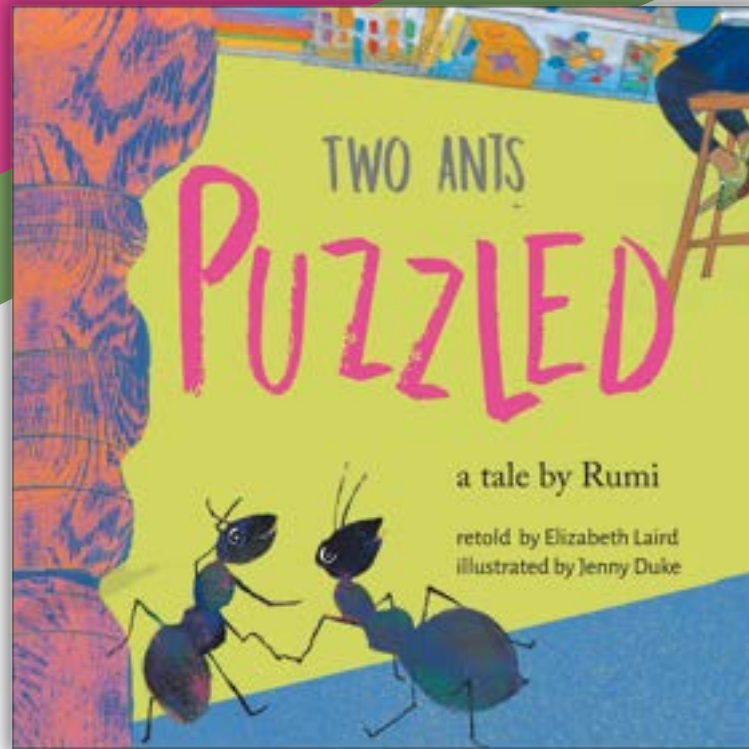
